

2025 JUBILEE PILGRIMATE

ITINERARY HIGHLIGHTS | FEBRUARY 18 - 28, 2025

DAY 1 | OVERNIGHT FLIGHT TO ITALY

Today we embark on our pilgrimage with an overnight flight(s) from your home city to Rome. Enjoy meals and refreshments served on the plane.

DAY 2 | ASSISI

After arriving into Rome Airport, we transfer by private motorcoach to the hilltop village of Assisi, the birthplace of St. Francis of Assisi. Upon arriving, will take you up to the most beautiful view of the city. After our hotel check-in, we will gather for prayer and Mass. Overnight in Assisi.

DAY 3 | ASSISI

Following breakfast, we will gather for our guided tour of Assisi. We begin at the Basilica of Saint Clare, one of the first followers of St. Francis. Here, we will descend to St. Clare's lower crypt, where we will pray before her incorrupt body. We will also have a chance to pray before the San Damiano cross, the very cross that Christ spoke to St. Francis through, asking Francis to rebuild his Church. Continuing to the Basilica of Saint Francis, we will be guided through the meaning of the many frescoes that surround us, depicting his saintly life. We will then have an opportunity to descend to the lower crypt where we will pray before the tomb of St. Francis, and the remains of his first followers. Today we will also visit the Chiesa Nueova and San Francesco Piccolino. Overnight in Assisi.

DAY 4 | JUBILEE OF DEACONS EVENTS

Today we will make our way down into the valley of Assisi where we visit the beautiful Basilica of Saint Mary of the Angels, home of the Chapel Portiuncula, where St. Francis lived and worked after founding the Franciscan order, and where Mother Mary appeared to Francis in 1216. All roads lead to Rome. We arrive in time to participate in the Jubilee of Deacons related events. Extra touring available for those who don't wish to participate in the Jubilee of Deacons events. DAY 5 & 6 | JUBILEE OF DEACONS EVENTS

Today we participate in the events related to the "Jubilee of Deacons". Details to follow. Extra touring available for those who don't wish to participate in the Jubilee of Deacons events. Overnight in Rome.

DAY 7 | TOUR OF PAPAL BASILICAS

Today we will visit and have an opportunity to walk through the Holy Doors at the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Walls, the Basilica of St. Mary Major, and the Archbasilica of St. John Lateran. At the Archbasilica of St. John Lateran we also will have the opportunity to climb the Lateran Steps and attend Mass. Before we close the day, we will travel to the Pontifical North American College for a private tour, offering stunning views of Rome. Overnight in Rome.

DAY 8 | EXPLORING ANCIENT ROME

After breakfast, we will embark on a historic tour of Ancient Rome. We will stroll along cobblestone streets, lined with majestic stone pines, and visit the Colosseum, a grand amphitheater of the ancient world. Passing by the Roman Forum, we will witness the ruins of ancient government buildings. We'll finish the day visiting the Catacombs of St. Callixtus, a resting place of several popes from the 2nd to 4th centuries. Overnight in Rome.

DAY 9 | ROME / DAY AT THE VATICAN / PAPAL AUDIENCE

In the morning, we will head to Saint Peter's Square for the Papal general audience with Pope Francis (subject to the Pope's schedule). Afterward, we will have a private Mass nearby. After lunch on your own, we'll embark on a tour of the Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel, and St. Peter's Basilica. Scavi tour of the Vatican (subject to availability). At St. Peter's Basilica we will walk through the final Holy Door. This door is one of three entrances into St. Peter's Basilica, which along with the other Holy Doors usually remains closed, but when it is opened imparts an indulgence to those who walk through it. Tonight, we enjoy our farewell dinner. Overnight in Rome.

DAY 10 | ROME

Today we will have some free time in Rome at leisure to be able to absorb this wonderful experience. Overnight in Rome

DAY 11 | DEPARTURE

With a renewed sense of pilgrimage and an invigorated love of our Catholic faith, we will board our plane for our flight home.

Note: While we do our very best at making sure all items listed in your itinerary are included, there are times when conditions beyond our control affect your program/ itinerary, including but not limited to air carrier changes, delays, weather, political climate, time constraints, or changes by your tour leader and tour quide.

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: A deposit of \$500.00 per person is required to make a reservation. An additional payment of \$1,000.00 per person is due by August 18,2024. Final payment is due no less than 90 days prior to the departure date of the tour (December 18, 2024). Payment can be made by personal check or money order. Credit card payments will be accepted but will incur a 4% surcharge at the time of booking. Reservations received after December 18, 2024 may incur additional charges due to supplier contract terms.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS: If a passenger cancels his/her tour membership there will be a cancellation fee of \$100.00 per person to cover administrative and communication costs up until 121 days before departure. For cancellations 120-91 days before departure the cancellation fee will be\$250.00 per person. 90-61 days before departure the cancellation fee will be 50%of the Cost per person. There will be no refund for cancellations within 60 days of departure, no-shows, or partially completed tours. All cancellation requests must be addressed to Good Shepherd Travel in writing. Trip cancellation insurance is recommended.

Round-trip air transportation from Atlanta, GA (ATL) International Airport as indicated on the registration form. 10 nights hotel accommodations, based on two people sharing a double or twin-bedded room in Four star hotels by (local standards). All meals as outlined in the brochure consisting of full Local breakfasts (B) at the hotel and dinner. Sightseeing as outlined in the itinerary by private motor coaches, utilizing the services of a Government licensed, local English speaking tour guide. Entrance fees for attractions if applicable. BAGGAGE: You may check no more than one (1) piece of luggage whose overall dimensions does not exceed 62 inches (length + width + height) and whose weight does not exceed fifty (50) pounds in total. Checking a second bag will cost up to \$100.00. Each passenger may also bring one (1) piece of carry-on luggage. Tips to hotel porters are included for one normal sized piece of luggage, excluding carry- on bags which must remain in your possession at all times. These regulations may change without notice so please read the monthly correspondence you will receive from Good Shepherd Travel for the most current information. Garment bags cannot be carried. Under no circumstances may dangerous articles such as firearms, explosives, oxygen, or combustible substances be contained in any baggage. Medications, valuables, passports, and a change of clothing should be packed in your carry-on bag.
