Day 1 | Sunday, March 8, 2026 : Arrival in Cairo


Depart for your overnight flight to Egypt. Meals will be served on board.

Day 2 | Monday, March 9, 2026 : Departure

 Arrival at Cairo International Airport. Transfer to your hotel for check-in. Dinner at the hotel and overnight stay.

Day 3 | Tuesday, March 10, 2026 : Cairo Exploration

• Breakfast at the hotel. Morning Visit: The Great Pyramid of Giza and the Sphinx at the Giza Plateau. Afternoon Visit: The Grand Egyptian Museum (the largest museum in the world). Evening: Dinner at the hotel. Overnight stay in Cairo.



 Breakfast at the hotel. Drive to Alexandria (approximately 2.5-3 hours). Morning Visit: The Greco-Roman Museum, the Catacombs of Kom el Shoqafa, and the famous Bibliotheca Alexandrina (Alexandria Library). Lunch: Enjoy dinner by the Mediterranean Sea. Drive back to Cairo in the afternoon. Overnight stay in Cairo.



 Breakfast at the hotel. Fly to Aswan (flight duration is approximately 1.5 hours). Upon Arrival: Embark on your Nile Cruise before lunch. Afternoon Visit: The High Dam and Philae Temple. Evening: Dinner on board and overnight stay.

Day 6 | Friday, March 13, 2026 : Kom Ombo & Sail to Edfu

• Breakfast on board. Morning Visit: Sail to Kom Ombo and explore Kom Ombo Temple. Afternoon: Return to the cruise for lunch and relax on board. Evening: Overnight on board.

Day 7 | Saturday, March 14, 2026 : Edfu Temple & Sail to Luxor

• Breakfast on board. Morning Visit: Enjoy a carriage ride to visit Edfu Temple. Afternoon: Sail towards Luxor, arriving in the afternoon. Evening Visit: Luxor Temple, lit up beautifully at night. Overnight on board.

Day 8 | Sunday, March 15, 2026 : Luxor Highlights & Return to Cairo

• Disembarkation after breakfast. Morning Visit: Visit the Valley of the Kings to explore 3 colorful tombs of the royal kings. Visit: The Queen Hatshepsut Temple and Karnak Temple. Afternoon: Fly back to Cairo. Dinner and overnight stay in Cairo.

Day 9 | Monday, March 16, 2026 : Explore Old Cairo & Travel to St. Catherine

 Breakfast at the hotel in Cairo. Morning Visit: Explore Old Cairo, including the ancient churches on the Babylonian Fortress (such as St. Sergius and the Hanging Church). Visit: Ben Ezra Synagogue. Afternoon: Drive to St. Catherine via Moses' Exodus Route. Dinner and overnight stay in St. Catherine.

Day 10 | Tuesday, March 17, 2026 : Mount Sinai & Sharm El Sheikh

Early Morning: Climb Mount Sinai (the site where Moses received the Ten Commandments). Descend
and enjoy breakfast at the hotel. Visit: St. Catherine's Monastery, the Burning Bush, and Moses' Well.
Afternoon: Drive to Sharm El Sheikh (approx. 2 hours). Free time to enjoy the Red Sea shore. Dinner and
overnight in Sharm El Sheikh.

Day 11 | Wednesday, March 18, 2026 : Return to Cairo

Breakfast in Sharm El Sheikh. Drive from Sharm El Sheikh to Cairo. Dinner and overnight stay in Cairo.

Day 12 | Thursday, March 19, 2026 : Departure

Breakfast at the hotel in Cairo. Transfer to Cairo International Airport for your departure.

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: A deposit of \$500.00 per person is required to make a reservation. An additional payment of \$750.00 per person is due six months before departure.
