2025 HOLY LAND PILGRIMAGE HIGHLIIGHTS OCTOBER 07 -17, 2025











Day 1, October 7th, 2025 (Tuesday): Departure

Depart for your overnight flight to Holy Land. Meals will be served on board the flight.

Day 2, October 8th, 2025 (Wednesday): Tel-Aviv arrival – Tiberias

Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport, Tel Aviv. Meet and assist by your Guide. Transfer to your hotel in Tiberias for check-in and dinner. Overnight in Tiberias (D)

Day 3, October 9th, 2025 (Thursday): Caesarea Maritima – Mt. Carmel – Megiddo – Cana

Start our visit to Caesarea Marittima (included), Mount Carmel (included), Megiddo (included), the place Biblical Armageddon, stop at Cana of Galilee. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias (B,L,D)

Day 4, October 10th, 2025 (Friday): boat ride, Caesarea Philippi, Sea of Galilee: Mt. of Beatitudes, Church of the Multiplication, Capernaum – Yardenit

We will start our day with the boat ride (included) on the Sea of Galilee. Visit Caesarea Philippi (included), view the Mount Hermon from the distance, the highest mountain in Israel. Visit Mount of Beatitudes, Church of Multiplications, Capernaum (included). On to Yardenit for renewal of the baptismal vows. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias (B,L,D)

Day 5, October 11th, 2025 (Saturday): Magdala – Nazareth – Jordan River baptismal site – Jericho – Jerusalem panoramic view

Check out of our hotel in Galilee and head south towards Jerusalem. Stop to visit Magdala (included) by the Sea of Galilee. Then proceed to Nazareth and visit Nazareth village (included). Drive through the Jordan valley, visit the baptismal site on the Jordan River, visit Jericho (Tel Jericho included), Elisha Spring and view Mount Temptation Monastery. Drive up to the Holy city of Jerusalem and panoramic view over the Jerusalem from Mount Scopus. Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem (B,L,D)

Day 6, October 12th, 2025 (Sunday): Jerusalem: City of David, Hezekiah's Tunnel, the Wailing Wall, Israel Museum, Yad Vashem

This morning we will visit City of David (included), see the Hezekiah's Tunnel, Pool of Siloam. Visit the Wailing Wall. In the afternoon Israel Museum (included) and Yad Vashem (included). Sunday night Church service at King of Kings (subject to confirmation) Overnight in Jerusalem. (B,L,D)

Day 7, October 13th, 2025 (Monday): Jerusalem: Mt. of Olives, Gethsemane Garden, Herodian** – Bethlehem & Shepherd's Field

Visit the Mount of Olives and the Garden of Gethsemane. Visit Herodian** (included, **visit is subject to confirmation due to renovation), Herod's summer palace and his burial place. Visit Bethlehem and the Church of the Nativity, Shepherds Field, shop in Bethlehem. Dinner at Cheers Restaurant (included, subject to confirmation). Overnight in Bethlehem. (B,L,D)

Day 8, October 14th, 2025 (Tuesday): Masada – Qumran – Dead Sea swim

Full day tour in the Dead Sea area, we will visit Masada (included), Qumran (included) and swim in the Dead Sea (access to the beach included). Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem (B,L,D)

Day 9, October 15th, 2025 (Wednesday): Jerusalem: Temple Mount, Davidson Center, Mt. Zion

Visit the Temple Mount where the Temple of Jerusalem stood. Then we will visit Davidson Centre (included). Mount Zion and the Upper Room. On to David's Tomb. Free afternoon for personal reflection. Dinner and overnight in your hotel in Jerusalem. (B,L,D)

Day 10, October 16th, 2025 (Thursday): Jerusalem: Garden of Gethsemane prayer, Caiaphas' House, Ecce Homo, Via Dolorosa, the Garden Tomb

Start the day with private prayer at Gethsemane Garden. On to Caiaphas Palace (included), Ecce Homo (included), biblical Gabatha. Follow Stations of the Cross to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, walk through different quarters of Jerusalem and then the Garden Tomb (donation included). Farewell Dinner with folklore show in a local restaurant in Bethlehem (included). Overnight in Jerusalem. (B,L,D)

Day 11, October 17th, 2025 (Friday): Jerusalem – Tel-Aviv departure

After breakfast, check out of our hotel and head to the airport for our journey back home. (B)

Note: While we do our very best at making sure all items listed in your itinerary are included, there are times when conditions beyond our control affect your program/itinerary, including but not limited to air carrier changes, delays, weather, political climate, time constraints, or changes by your tour leader and tour guide.

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: A deposit of \$500.00 per person is required to make a reservation. An additional payment of \$1000.00 per person is due six months prior to departure. The final payment is due no less than 90 days prior to the departure date of the tour. Payment can be made by check or money order at Credit card payments will only be accepted for the full price of the tour cost at the time of booking. Reservations received within 90 days of departure may incur additional charges due to supplier contract terms.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS: If a passenger cancels his/her tour membership there will be a cancellation fee of \$100.00 per person to cover administrative and communication costs up until 121 days before departure. For cancellations 120-91 days before departure the cancellation fee will be \$250.00 per person. 90-61 days before departure the cancellation fee will be \$0% of the Cost per person. There will be no refund for cancellations within 60 days of departure, no-shows, or partially completed tours. All cancellation insurance is recommended.

FARE INCLUSIVE: Roundtrip air transportation from Charlotte, NC (CLT) indicated on the registration form. Nine (9) nights hotel accommodations, based on two people sharing a double or twin-bedded room in four-star hotels by (local standards). All meals as outlined in the brochure consisting of full Local breakfasts (B) and dinners at the hotel (D). Sightseeing as outlined in the itinerary by private motor coaches, utilizing the services of a Government licensed, local English-speaking tour guide. Entrance fees for attractions if applicable.
