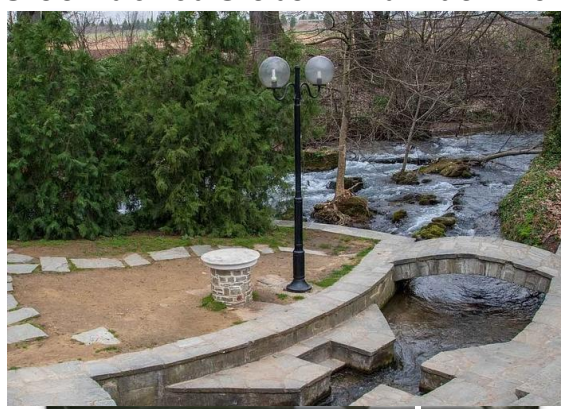

2026 GREECE STEPS OF PAUL JOURNEY HIGHLIGHTS

June 08 - 20, 2026



Day 1: Departure to Greece

Overnight flight to Greece, meals onboard.

Day 2: Arrival in Thessaloniki

Arrive in Thessaloniki, transfer to the hotel, and enjoy a welcome dinner. Overnight at Hotel Capsis (or similar).

Day 3: Thessaloniki

Tour Thessaloniki, including the White Tower, Archaeological Museum, St. Demetrios Basilica (Acts 17:1-9), and other key sites. Visit the crypt of St. Demetrios, and worship with Holy Communion. Overnight at Hotel Capsis (or similar).

Day 4: Thessaloniki – Kavala – Philippi

Visit Kavala (Acts 16:11), the site where Paul first set foot in Europe, and Philippi (Acts 16:12-18). Explore Lydia's Baptistery and the prison site of St. Paul (Acts 16:16-40). Return to Thessaloniki. Overnight at Hotel Capsis (or similar).

Day 5: Thessaloniki – Veria – Vergina – Meteora – Kalambaka

Visit Veria (Acts 17:10-12) and the Royal Tombs of Vergina (including King Philip II's tomb). Explore Meteora's monasteries, perched atop rock formations, and learn about the monks who sought refuge there. Overnight at Hotel Amalia (or similar).

Day 6: Kalambaka – Delphi – Athens

Drive to Delphi (Acts 18:12-17), where Paul's trial is linked to the inscription mentioning proconsul Gallio. Visit the archaeological site and museum. Continue to Athens. Overnight at the Athens Avenue Hotel (or similar).

Day 7: Athens

Visit the Acropolis, Mars Hill (Acts 17:23-18:18), and other key sites. Walk through the agora, where Paul preached to the Athenians. Enjoy a food tour and free time. Overnight at Athens Avenue Hotel (or similar).

Day 8: Athens/Piraeus – Mykonos

Embark on a 3-night cruise to Mykonos. Explore Mykonos Town. Meals onboard.

Day 9: Kusadasi/Ephesus/Patmos

Visit Ephesus (Acts 20:31), where Paul spent three years and wrote his First Epistle to the Corinthians. See the House of Virgin Mary. Continue to Patmos, where St. John wrote the Book of Revelation (Revelation 1:9-11). Visit the Monastery of St. John and the Holy Grotto. Meals onboard.

Day 10: Rhodes

Today, we will visit the Island of Rhodes. The ship enters the port, which was once dominated by the Colossus, one of the seven wonders of the ancient world. Shore excursion not included.

Day 11: Heraklion (Crete) – Santorini

Stop at Heraklion, where Paul met the ship's captain (Acts 27:7-12). Option to visit the Palace of Knossos. Later, visit Santorini, the "Black Pearl of the Aegean." Celebrate Holy Communion onboard. Meals onboard.

Day 12: Piraeus – Athens – Corinth

Disembark and visit Corinth (Acts 18:1-17), where Paul preached and was tried. See the Temple of Apollo and the Bema. Visit the Corinth Canal and enjoy wine tasting at a local winery. Overnight at Athens Avenue Hotel (or similar).

Day 13: Departure from Athens

Transfer to Athens Airport for your return flight.

Note: Although we make every effort to ensure that all items listed in your itinerary are included, certain factors beyond our control may impact your program. These can include, but are not limited to, changes by the air carrier, delays, weather conditions, political situations, time restrictions, or adjustments made by your tour leader and guide.

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: A deposit of \$500.00 per person is required to make a reservation. An additional payment of \$1000.00 per person is due six months before departure. The final payment is due no less than 90 days prior to the departure date of the tour. Payment can be made by personal check or money order. Credit card payments will be accepted but will incur a 4% surcharge at the time of booking. Reservations received less than 90 days prior to departure may incur additional charges due to supplier contract terms. Upgrades and Deviations: In the event that you elect to upgrade or make modifications beyond the scope of the included package, additional payments may be required upon confirmation of such upgrade or deviation.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS: If a passenger cancels his/her tour membership there will be a cancellation fee of \$250.00 per person to cover administrative and communication costs up until 121 days before departure. For cancellations 120-91 days before departure the cancellation fee will be \$500.00 per person. 90-61 days before departure the cancellation fee will be 50% of the Cost per person. There will be no refund for cancellations within 60 days of departure, no-shows, or partially completed tours. All cancellation requests must be addressed to Good Shepherd Travel in writing. Trip cancellation insurance is recommended.

FARE INCLUSIVE: Roundtrip air transportation from Anchorage, AK (ANC) indicated on the registration form. Nine (9) nights hotel accommodations, based on two people sharing a double or twin-bedded room in four-star hotels by (local standards). All meals as outlined in the brochure consisting of full Local breakfasts (B) and dinners at the hotel (D). Sightseeing as outlined in the itinerary by private motor coaches, utilizing the services of a Government licensed, local English-speaking tour guide. Entrance fees for attractions if applicable. All transfers between airports and hotels by private motor coach. Service charges and taxes normally levied by hotels and restaurants. All U.S. & European departure taxes are included in the price of the tour. Tips to guides, motor coach drivers, hotel porters, and restaurant staff (i.e., maitre d', table waiter, etc.) are Not included. The brochure price is per person in US dollars.

AIR ROUTINGS: The brochure price includes IATA jet economy class transportation from the international departure city applicable on all IATA and ARC carriers, based on the 6/45-day Apex fare to the Europe. Good Shepherd Travel. Reserves the right to choose the air carrier, routing, and departure time for each passenger. Airfares used are based on contracted group fares and are highly restrictive. Payments for and restrictions on airline tickets are governed by the applicable fare. Cancellation fees levied by the airlines are applicable if you cancel or change your air ticket for any reason after purchase of air ticket. Ticketing must be completed 45 days prior to departure. Group fares do not permit deviations; passengers who wish to deviate may arrange their own airfare. An airline credit of \$1390.00 will be given to those passengers who arrange their own airfare. Seat numbers will be assigned by the airline at check-in; specific seat requests cannot be guaranteed. Passengers are responsible for providing frequent flyer information upon check-in.

HOTELS: Tour prices are per person, based on two people sharing a room in Deluxe

hotels. Single rooms are subject to availability and at an additional cost of \$1290.00 (tour participants without a roommate will have to pay single room surcharge). **BAGGAGE:** You may check no more than one (1) piece of luggage whose overall dimensions does not exceed 62 inches (length + width + height) and whose weight does not exceed fifty (50) pounds in total. Checking a second bag will cost up to \$100.00. Each passenger may also bring one (1) piece of carry-on luggage. Tips to hotel porters are included for one normal sized piece of luggage, excluding carry-on bags which must remain in your possession at all times. These regulations may change without notice so please read the monthly correspondence you will receive from Good Shepherd Travel for the most current information. Garment bags cannot be carried. Good Shepherd Travel reserves the right to refuse passage to someone who is in such physical or mental condition as to be unfit for travel or who may require care and attention beyond that which the tour guide and tour host can provide.
