# 2026 REFORMATION PILGRIMAGE TO GERMANY

## ITINERARY HIGHLIGHTS | OCTOBER 27 - NOVEMBER 7, 2026

### DAY 1 | DEPARTURE

Depart for your overnight flight to Germany, meals will be served on board.

### DAY 2 | FRANKFURT ARRIVAL - MAINZ TOUR

Arrival to Frankfurt airport and meet your professional tour escort. Explore the old town of Mainz. Visit Gutenberg Museum, see one of the original Gutenberg Bibles. Visit St. Stephen's Church - Marc Chagall stained-glass windows symbolize reconciliation after WWII, a guided city tour through the old town of Mainz. Welcome dinner with wine from vineyards in Rheinhessen at a local restaurant Overnight at the hotel in Mainz. **(D)**

### DAY 3 | MAINZ - WORMS TOUR - EISENACH (WARTBURG CASTLE)

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out, depart to Worms. Worms tour includes Luther Monument, St. Peter's Cathedral and site of the Diet of Worms. Lunch on your own. Depart for Eisenach. Tour of Wartburg Castle where Luther translated the New Testament in exile. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Eisenach. **(B, D)**

### DAY 4 | EISENACH - LEIPZIG TOUR

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Enjoy a guided Leipzig tour. Visit St. Thomas Church where Luther preached, introducing Reformation ideas, and later where Johann Sebastian Bach worked as cantor and director of music. Visit St. Nicholas' Church, center for the peaceful prayers and protests that helped bring down East German communism in 1989. Visit Bach Museum in Leipzig. Dinner at a local restaurant with German cuisine. Overnight at the hotel in Leipzig. **(B, D)**

### DAY 5 | LEIPZIG - WITTENBERG TOUR

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Depart for Wittenberg. Visit Wittenberg All Saints Castle Church (Schlosskirche) where Luther nailed his 95 Theses here in 1517. Visit St. Mary's Church, the town church where Luther often preached. Visit Lutherhaus exhibition in Augusteum: Luther's former monastery home turned into a Reformation museum, with artifacts from his life and work. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Wittenberg. **(B, D)**

### DAY 6 | WITTENBERG - BERLIN TOUR

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Worship at Wittenberg All Saints Castle Church. Walking tour of Berlin's civic and spiritual heart to include Reichstag, Brandenburg Gate, Holocaust Memorial and Memorial Church (Kaiser Wilhelm Gedächtniskirche). Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Berlin. **(B, D)**

### DAY 7 | BERLIN

Breakfast at the hotel. Visit Topography of Terror (Nazi Resistance Museum) located on the former SS and Gestapo headquarters site. Visit to Bonhoeffer-Haus, former home and memorial. Free time for leisure activities. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Berlin. **(B, D)**

### DAY 8 | BERLIN - HERRNHUT - DRESDEN

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Visit Herrnhutter Sterne Manufactory. Visit Zinzendorf Church in Herrnhut and listen about Moravian Daily Texts which Bonhoeffer himself used. Continue to Dresden. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Dresden. **(B, D)**

### DAY 9 | DRESDEN TOUR - PRAGUE

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out. Guided tour of Dresden's Old Town to include Zwinger Palace, Semper Opera, Elbe river walk. Focus on WWII destruction & postwar restoration. Drive to Prague. Dinner at a local restaurant with folk show. Overnight at the hotel in Prague. **(B, D)**

### DAY 10 | PRAGUE TOUR

Breakfast at the hotel. Tour of Prague. You will see Jan Hus Memorial: a forerunner of the Reformation. Visit Old New Synagogue: One of Europe's oldest synagogues. See Bethlehem Chapel: Where Hus preached in the early 1400s. Free time for leisure activities. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Prague. **(B, D)**


### DAY 11 | PRAGUE TOUR

Breakfast at the hotel. Guided tour of Prague, including the castle district (Hradcany). Visit St. Vitus' Cathedral with Wenceslas Chapel. Stroll through Mala Strana with its amazing architectural buildings. Cross the Charles Bridge to visit the Old Town, one of the best historical city centers in Europe. Visit the Old Town Square, the Town Hall with its famous Astronomical Clock. Afternoon and evening free for walking tour on your own and reflection. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Prague. **(B, D)**

### DAY 12 | PRAGUE DEPARTURE

Breakfast at the hotel (or pick up the breakfast boxes) and check-out. Drive to Prague International Airport for your departure flight home. **(B)**

*Note: While we do our very best at making sure all items listed in your itinerary are included, there are times when conditions beyond our control affect your program/itinerary, including but not limited to air carrier changes, delays, weather, political climate, time constraints, or changes by your tour leader and tour guide.*



**DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS:** A deposit of \$500.00 per person is required to make a reservation. An additional payment of \$750.00 per person is due 4 months prior to departure. The final payment is due no less than 90 days prior to the departure date of the tour (October 27, 2026). Payment can be made by personal check or money order. Credit card payments will be accepted but will incur a 4% surcharge at the time of booking. Reservations received less than 90 days prior to departure may incur additional charges due to supplier contract terms.

**CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS:** If a passenger cancels his/her tour membership there will be a cancellation fee of \$100.00 per person to cover administrative and communication costs up until 121 days before departure. For cancellations 120-91 days before departure the cancellation fee will be \$250.00 per person. 90-61 days before departure the cancellation fee will be 50% of the Cost per person. There will be no refund for cancellations within 60 days of departure, no-shows, or partially completed tours. All cancellation requests must be addressed to Good Shepherd Travel in writing. *Trip cancellation insurance is recommended.*

**FARE INCLUSIVE.** Roundtrip air transportation from Pittsburgh, PA (PIT) International Airport as indicated on the registration form. 7 nights hotel accommodations, based on two people sharing a double or twin-bedded room in four star hotels by (local standards). 3 nights Cabin accommodation in Standard Inside Cabin IB Category. All meals as outlined in the brochure consisting of full Local breakfasts (B) at the hotel and Lunch. Sightseeing as outlined in the itinerary by private motor coaches, utilizing the services of a Government licensed, local English speaking tour guide. Entrance fees for attractions if applicable. All transfers between airports and hotels by private motor coach. Service charges and taxes normally levied by hotels and restaurants. All U.S. & Foreign Country departure taxes are included in the price of the tour. Tips to guides, motor coach drivers, hotel porters, and restaurant staff (i.e., maitre d', table waiter, etc.) are Not included. The brochure price is per person in US dollars.

**TOUR ITINERARY SUBJECT TO CHANGE:** Good Shepherd Travel constantly strives to adhere to the specifics shown in the itinerary; however, circumstances may necessitate changes. Such circumstances may require changes without advance notice during the tour. Good Shepherd Travel reserves the right to change the Itinerary if unforeseen circumstances beyond our control force a change. Good Shepherd Travel is not responsible for any changes caused by unforeseen circumstances.

**TOUR CANCELLATION:** Good Shepherd Travel reserves the right to cancel or withdraw the tour at any time. In the event of a cancellation deemed necessary by Good Shepherd Travel, the sole and exclusive responsibility of Good Shepherd Travel is to refund all monies recovered.

**NOT INCLUDED:** Passport costs, visa fees (if any), and health documentation costs (when required); food and beverages (including coffee and tea) not usually included with the table d'hote meals; optional sightseeing tours and excursions; accident and baggage insurance; transporting and handling excess luggage; tips to persons rendering special personal services; items of a purely person-

**AIR ROUTINGS:** The brochure price includes IATA jet economy class transportation from the international departure city applicable on all IATA and ARC carriers, based on the 6/45 day Apex fare to Europe. Good Shepherd Travel. Reserves the right to choose the air carrier, routing, and departure time for each passenger. Airfares used are based on contracted group fares and are highly restrictive. Payments for and restrictions on airline tickets are governed by the applicable fare. Cancellation fees levied by the airlines are applicable if you cancel or change your air ticket for any reason after purchase of air ticket. Ticketing must be completed 45 days prior to departure. Group fares do not permit deviations; passengers who wish to deviate may arrange their own airfare. An airline credit of \$1190.00 will be given to those passengers who arrange their own airfare. Passengers planning to arrange their own air transportation must notify Good Shepherd Travel in writing on or before 90 days prior to departure. Seat numbers will be assigned by the airline at check-in; specific seat requests cannot be guaranteed. Passengers are responsible for providing frequent flyer information upon check-in.

**HOTELS:** Tour prices are per person, based on two people sharing a room in Deluxe hotels. Single rooms are subject to availability and at an additional cost of \$1090.00 (tour participants without a roommate will have to pay single room surcharge).

**BAGGAGE:** You may check no more than one (1) piece of luggage whose overall dimensions does not exceed 62 inches (length + width + height) and whose weight does not exceed fifty (50) pounds in total. Checking a second bag will cost up to \$100.00. Each passenger may also bring one (1) piece of carry-on luggage. Tips to hotel porters are included for one normal sized piece of luggage, excluding carry-on bags which must remain in your possession at all times. These regulations may change without notice so please read the monthly correspondence you will receive from Good Shepherd Travel for the most current information. Garment bags cannot be carried. Under no circumstances may dangerous articles such as firearms, explosives, oxygen, or combustible substances be contained in any baggage. Medications, valuables, passports, and a change of clothing should be packed in your carry-on bag.

**DISABILITIES:** Due to the difficult terrain at sites we visit, persons requiring oxygen or oxygen therapy will not be permitted on the tour. For reasons of passenger safety and well-being, persons with impaired mobility, vision, or mental capacity will not be permitted on the tour. Good Shepherd Travel reserves the right to refuse passage to someone who is in such physical or mental condition as to be unfit for travel or who may require care and attention beyond that which the tour guide and tour host can provide. The tour requires a substantial amount of walking and the sites are not accessible by wheelchair.

**INSURANCE:** Acting only as agents for suppliers, Good Shepherd Travel is not responsible for damage, loss, or theft of luggage and/or personal belongings, or for personal injury, accident, illness
